March SIMS Report

Note sent out from the DESE:

The data submitted will be as of this date, March 2nd. Starting today (March 2nd), if your data is error free, you can freeze, run summary reports and certify.

The initial certification deadline is Thursday March 19th. We need to have as many districts as possible certified by this date so we can run and publish duplicate students. The final certification deadline is Thursday March 26th, after duplicates have been reviewed and resolved.

Some reminders and updates on summary reports:

When reviewing your summary reports prior to certifying, don't forget to review Summary Report 16 (Duplicate Enrollment Report). This report gives you a list of students who are being reported as enrolled in your district, and another public district is also reporting this student as enrolled on report date. Reviewing this preliminary duplicate list and making any necessary corrections will help reduce the number of conflicts that we have when we run final duplicates after the initial certification deadline of March 19th.

Also, in the Student Attendance summary reports (reports 17 and 18), there is a new detail view available that shows the list of SASIDs included in the chronic absenteeism calculation, and the list of students identified as being chronically absent. The chronic absenteeism counts on the summary reports are links – click the link and you will see a detail report with the lists of students that make up that count.
