Frequently Asked Questions

- Q. Is there a Forgot Password/Forgot Username option available for iPASS users?
- **A. Yes.** iPASS Administrators can set up some parameters for this feature to activate a User ID upon request, set the number of tries and amount of time a user has to utilize the feature, and enable the Forgot ID and/or Forgot Password feature for their district. <u>Click here for more information</u>.
- Q. Is there a report that shows the list of Recipients who received and viewed a published document?





- **A.** At this time there is a query available for upload to your My Queries folder. The Support Team has created a query they can be downloaded from iPASS Help and uploaded to your My Queries folder. The *Published Documents* Query will provide you with a list of the Recipients and whether they have viewed the published document. Go to iPASS Help > My Queries > Query Files for Download > <u>Published Documents</u>. - Q. *Pennsylvania:* I am reviewing my PIMS Student Calendar Fact extract prior to submission and wondering why my students are missing calendars?
