Prepare for Trimester 1 Report Cards

It is important to check your Report Cards now and not wait for the day you need to print them. It is highly recommended that you prepare in advance by running some example Report Cards to make sure that the Grades, Comments, and Attendance totals are printing as you expect. This will prevent printing errors and last minute struggles. We recommend selecting some sample students at each school, entering some fake grades if necessary, and creating example Report Cards to review. Look for any misalignments or missing/incorrect data. Refer to iPass Help > Grading > Help and FAQ sections for more information. If you find that you are experiencing any issues with your Report Cards, please enter an [eSupport ticket](#) with detailed information about your issue and provide an example Report Card.

iPASS TIPS & TRICKS

How to Enter a Snow/Weather Day or Other Emergency School Closing

When school is cancelled:

- Each school calendar must be updated to mark the day(s) as a Holiday to indicate no school.

- Schools that have rotating cycles may need to adjust their day/week cycles.
- School may need to adjust the Term Start and End Dates. Before adjusting your calendar, check for students that were marked absent in advance for that day. These students need to be updated to “Present” for the snow day(s) before the day is removed from the Calendar.

iPASS FAQs

Q. How do you delete a “Completed” Nurse Visit Record in iHealth?

- A. If a Nurse Visit Record is set to Completed = Yes, there is no option to delete. Before a completed Nurse Visit Record can be deleted, the record must be changed to Completed = No. Click the Submit button and the screen will refresh with a check box option for “Delete this Nurse Visit Record.” To delete the record, check the box and Submit.
